32 (144) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
33 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
34 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

36 SECTION 16. APPROPRIATION - WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM - CASH FUND

1 OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks,

 36 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
2 MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in the Conservation Tax Operations
3 appropriation section of this act for the Division of Arkansas State Parks
4 Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval by the
5 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special
6 maintenance program for the Park System. The funds provided will be used for
7 repair and upkeep of parks and museum facilities that have been deferred due
8 to lack of funds in the individual budgets of the parks and museums.

9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
10 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
11 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
12 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
13 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
14 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
15 has determined that the Division of Arkansas State Parks may operate more
16 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Parks,
17 Heritage, and Tourism authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore,
18 it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain
19 oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint
20 Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by
21 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of
22 this section or the Special Maintenance line item. If the requirement of
23 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
24 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section
25 and the Special Maintenance line item in the Conservation Tax Operations
26 appropriation section is void.

30 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

32 PRIZES - STATE PARKS. The Division of Arkansas State Parks is hereby
33 authorized to award merchandise, gift certificates, and cash prizes to
34 contestants in various special events authorized by the Division Director of
35 the Division of Arkansas State Parks. Such prizes may be awarded to the 1st,
36 2nd, and 3rd prize winners and shall be payable from the maintenance and

1 operation line item of the Parks - Cash Fund Operations appropriation
2 section. The cash prizes, in aggregate, for all contests, shall not exceed
3 \$10,000 per fiscal year.

7 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
9 MISSISSIPPI RIVER DOMESTIC - INTERNATIONAL MARKETING PLAN. Of the funds
10 appropriated to the Division of Arkansas Tourism - Great River Road for
11 operating expenses in the State Operations appropriation section of this act,
12 up to \$15,000 each year is authorized to be utilized for the implementation
13 of the Mississippi River Domestic - International Marketing Plan.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2024~~

17 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

19 FESTIVAL FUNDING. The General Assembly acknowledges the economic benefits of
20 festivals which attract visitors and stimulate the growth of tourism and
21 businesses statewide.

22 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or rules and regulations
23 promulgated by the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism to the
24 contrary, the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism shall dedicate,
25 commit, and budget annually one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
26 from the 2% tourism tax credited to the Tourism Development Trust Fund for
27 expense, advertising, marketing, or grants for small festivals in Arkansas
28 communities of less than 10,500 people. Any funds not granted out in a
29 fiscal year shall be available for other tourism promotion efforts.

35 HELP. The Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism may utilize their
36 authorized extra-help positions and contract labor event staff up to a

2 War Memorial Stadium. The rates of pay may not exceed those provided in the
3 Uniform Classification Act, or its successor, for the appropriate
4 classification.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2024~~
6 2025 through June 30, ~~2025~~ 2026.

7
8 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

10 PROMOTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS. The Division of Arkansas State Parks
11 and Tourism is hereby authorized to purchase from Maintenance and General
12 Operations appropriations provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed
13 \$75,000 each fiscal year, promotional and educational merchandise, authorized
14 by the Secretary of the Department of Arkansas Parks, Heritage, and Tourism,
15 to inform the public of the Division's programs, to promote the functions of
16 the Division, and to inform the public regarding services provided by the
17 Division.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2025,
19 through June 30, 2026.

20
21 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30
31 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3
4 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
5 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
6 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm
11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
14 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.

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
