SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 3, §1(a), concerning the

2	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ Except as otherwise provided by this Constitution, any person
3	may vote in an election in this state who is:
4	(1)(A) A citizen of the United States;

6	(3) (C) At least eighteen (18) years of age; and
7	$\frac{(4)}{(D)}$ Lawfully registered to vote in the election.
8	(2) A person who is seventeen (17) years of age and otherwise
9	qualified to vote in an election in this state may vote in the following
10	elections at which one (1) or more nominees are chosen to be voted upon at a
11	general election if the person will be eighteen (18) years of age on or
