SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

9 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING
10 BALLOT TITLES FOR INITIATED MEASURES; AND TO PROVIDE
11 THAT THE BALLOT TITLE FOR AN INITIATED MEASURE SHALL
12 BE READABLE, SHALL BE CLEAR AND CONCISE, AND SHALL
13 NOT EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED WORDS.

16 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS
17 CONSTITUTION CONCERNING BALLOT TITLES
18 FOR INITIATED MEASURES.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
22 STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the
33 Arkansas Constitution concerning ballot titles for initiated measures and to
34 provide that ballot titles for initiated measures shall be readable, shall be
35 clear and concise, and shall not exceed five hundred (500) words.
