21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-21-136 is amended to read as follows:
24 16-21-136. The Fourteenth Judicial District.

25 The Fourteenth Judicial District shall be a Division ~~B~~ A Judicial
26 "District."

28 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current caseload of the
30 Fourteenth Judicial District is burdensome for a part-time prosecuting
31 attorney; that the prosecuting attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial District
32 should be employed on a full-time basis; and that this act is immediately
33 necessary to ensure the efficient administration of justice in the Fourteenth
34 Judicial District. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act
35 being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
36 and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
