## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF AUTOMATED  
TELLER MACHINE IMPAIRMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF  
AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE IMPAIRMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 38, Subchapter 2, is amended  
to add an additional section to read as follows:

5-38-208. Automated teller machine impairment.

(a)(1) As used in this section, "automated teller machine" means an  
electronic information processing device located in this state that accepts  
or dispenses cash in connection with a financial transaction or credit card.

(2) "Automated teller machine" includes a customer-bank  
communication terminal.

(b) A person commits automated teller machine impairment if he or she  
purposely:

(1) Removes an automated teller machine; or

(2) Causes impairment or interruption of use, in whole or in  
part, of an automated teller machine.

(c) Automated teller machine impairment is a Class D felony.
