Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e)(1)(B)(i) is hereby amended to read 13 14 as follows, to reflect current sources of special revenues to the State 15 Central Services Fund: 16 "(i) Those special revenues as specified in subdivisions (11), (19), (21), 17 (75), (76), (77), (78), (79), (80), (82), (83), (84), (85), (86), (87), (88), (89), (90), (91), (92), (96), (112), (116), (118), (124), (131), 18 (149) and ten percent (10%) of those special revenues as set out in 19 20 subsection (20) of §19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law of 21 Arkansas, §19-6-101 et seq.;" 22 23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(s) is hereby amended to read as 24 follows: 25 "(s)(1) NORTHWEST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE FUND. There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, State Auditor, and 26 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Northwest 27 Arkansas Community College Fund. This fund shall be used for the 28 maintenance, operation and improvement of the Northwest Arkansas 29 30 Community College. 31 (2) The fund shall consist of: (A) Such general revenues as may be provided by law; and 32 (B)Any other funds made available for the support of the Northwest 33 Arkansas Community College, and which are required to be 34 deposited into the State Treasury by law." 35 36

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1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-304(1)(B)(ii) is hereby amended to read 2 as follows, to reflect current sources of revenues to the Vocational Education 3 Administration Fund Account: "(ii) The fund account shall consist of those general revenues as may be 4 5 provided by the Revenue Stabilization Law." 6 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 19-5-306(2)(B) is hereby amended to read as 7 8 follows, to reflect current sources of income to the Developmental 9 Disabilities Services Fund Account: 10 "(B) The fund account shall consist of: 11 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; 12 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived by services provided by the human development 13 centers; 14 (iii)Funds received from local sources to provide matching for community 15 developmental disabilities services programs; and 16 (iv)Reimbursement received from the Division of Economic and Medical Services." 17 18 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 19-5-307(b)(1) is hereby amended to read as 19 20 follows, to reflect current sources of special revenue to the Public Health 21 Fund: 22 "(1) Those special revenues as set out in subdivisions (65), (66), (69), (97), (133), (136), (137), (139), (140), (141), (142), (143), (144), (147), 23 and (155) of §19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law;" 24 25 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code §19-5-602(a)(3) is hereby amended to read as 26 27 follows, to reflect current sources of special revenue to the County Aid Fund: Those special revenues as set out in Subdivisions (74), (117) and forty-28 "(3) five percent (45%) of those special revenues as specified in Subdivision 29 30 (20) of §19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law; and" 31 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 19-5-946 is hereby amended to read as follows: 32 33 "19-5-946. County Collectors Continuing Education Trust Fund. There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, State 34 Auditor, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the 35

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"County Collector's Continuing Education Trust Fund". Such fund shall 1 2 consist of fees, as annually appropriated by the Quorum Court of each 3 county, of the Office of County Collector and such funds withheld from the County Aid Fund for those counties which fail or refuse to provide 4 5 such appropriated fees, there to be used exclusively for the 6 establishment and operation of a continuing education program for county collectors and sheriff/collectors, as set out in §14-15-1001." 7

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SECTION 8. Arkansas Code 19-5-1004(b)(2) is hereby amended to read as 10 follows:

11 "(2) The portion not determined to be special revenues by §19-6-110 of the year-end balances of the funds and fund accounts created in §§19-5-302, 12 19-5-304 (1), (3), (4), (5), and (6), 19-5-306, 19-5-307, 19-6-404, and 13 14 19-6-411, which fund balances are to be transferred on or before August 15 15 of the fiscal year next following the fiscal year during which 16 balances accrued. Provided, however, that the unspent balance of those funds used by the State Department of Higher Education under the 17 provisions of §19-5-302 (7), appropriated and funded for the operation 18 19 of the State Scholarship Assistance Grants Program and the 20 Teacher/Administrator Grants Program, shall be exempt from the 21 provisions of this subdivision and shall remain deposited in the 22 Department of Higher Education Fund Account, and be carried forward, provided that such funds are used solely for providing financial aid 23 grants for each year of the biennium. In addition, any funds which remain in the Vocational-28 Technical Schools Fund Account at the end of a fiscal year due to the 29 30 provisions of this section, shall be transferred by the Chief Fiscal 31 Officer of the State to the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, there to be used exclusively to provide 32 33 additional funding for appropriations for vocational-technical schools which are made payable from the General Improvement Fund or its 34 successor fund or fund accounts." 35

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3 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code 19-5-1025 is hereby amended to read as 4 follows:

5 "19-5-1025. DHS CONSOLIDATED COST REVOLVING FUND. There is hereby 6 established on the books of the State Treasurer, State Auditor, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the "DHS 7 Consolidated Cost Revolving Fund". Such fund shall be used by the 8 9 Department of Human Services, Division of Management Services for the purposes of providing a system to charge consolidated costs for such 10 items as: postage, vehicle maintenance, vehicle insurance, vehicle 11 license and title fees, tires and tubes, fuel, credit card purchases, 12 office supplies, micrographic supplies, sales and use taxes, and various 13 14 other licenses and permits. These items will be purchased by the 15 Division of Management Services through the use of the revolving fund 16 and charged to each Division and Office as that Division or Office uses This will allow for the expenditure to be appropriately charged to 17 it. the benefiting program. The replenishment of the revolving fund will 18 19 consist of such funds as budgeted by the division and offices for these 20 items of cost which could be general revenue, special revenue, federal 21 funds, cash funds or any other funds under the authority of the 22 divisions and offices. Said account shall be replenished as needed but 23 not less than six times per fiscal year. Said account shall be established and maintained in accordance with procedures established by 24 25 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The Department of Human Services shall have one time transfer authority to establish the DHS Consolidated 26 Cost Revolving Fund. The initial transfer of funds to this account 27 shall be made from the general revenue funds of the various Department 28 of Human Services divisions and offices participating in the account." 29

16	used for administering continuing education provisions for insurance
17	agents, solicitors, consultants and brokers as set out in $\S23-64-301$ et
18	seq.

21	There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, State

This fund shall consist of those assessed penalties and 7 monies provided for in Arkansas Code §5-64-416.

8 19-5-1044. Law Enforcement and Prosecutor Drug Enforcement Training 9 Fund. There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, State 10 Auditor, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the 'Law 11 Enforcement and Prosecutor Drug Enforcement Training Fund'. This fund shall 12 consist of those assessed penalties and monies provided for in Arkansas Code 13 §5-64-416."

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SECTION 20. Emergency Clause. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that the distribution of general revenues and the creation of the various funds and fund accounts are essential to be in force at the beginning of the state fiscal year and that in the event that the General Assembly extends beyond the sixty day limit, the effective date of this act would not begin at that time creating confusion and not permitting the agencies to implement those programs as approved by the General Assembly. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
