## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 27-36-215(c) TO  
10 PROHIBIT THE USE OF COLORED LIGHTS TO ILLUMINATE THE  
11 REGISTRATION PLATE ON A MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF COLORED LIGHTS  
16 TO ILLUMINATE THE REGISTRATION PLATE ON  
17 A MOTOR VEHICLE"

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-36-215(c) is amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "(c)(1) Either a tail lamp or a separate lamp shall be so constructed  
24 and placed as to illuminate with a white light the rear registration plate and  
25 render it clearly legible for a distance of fifty feet (50) to the rear. It  
26 shall be a violation of this subsection for any other color of light to be  
27 displayed around the registration plate, or for the excessive use of white  
28 light that renders the registration plate illegible from a distance of less  
29 than fifty feet (50).

30 (2) Any tail lamp or tail lamps, together with any separate lamp  
31 for illuminating the rear registration plate, shall be so wired as to be  
32 lighted whenever the headlamps or auxiliary driving lamps are lighted."  
33

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
