## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OF HAND-HELD LASER  
10 POINTERS BY MINORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OF  
14 HAND-HELD LASER POINTERS BY MINORS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. (a) It is unlawful for a person under eighteen (18) years  
20 of age to possess a hand-held laser pointer without the supervision of a  
21 parent, guardian or teacher.

22 (b) The hand-held laser pointer shall be seized by the law  
23 enforcement officer as contraband.  
24

25 SECTION 2. Each school district shall adopt a policy providing for  
26 seizure, by school personnel, of hand-held laser pointers in the possession of  
27 students.  
28

29 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
32

33 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
