18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-30-215 is amended to read as follows:

21 "12-30-215. Purchase for construction or operation of prison.

22 Any contractor or subcontractor who has entered into a contract with or for
23 the benefit of ~~the Department of Correction or Department of Community~~
24 ~~Punishment~~ a state board, state agency, or state-supported institution of
25 higher education ~~for the construction and/or operation~~ constructing,
26 equipping, or operating, in whole or in part, ~~of a state prison facility~~ any
27 facility of said board, agency, or institution may purchase goods produced by
28 the Department of Correction and Department of Community Punishment for use in
29 the performance of such contract."
30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
34

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
