10 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIME OF VIDEO VOYEURISM; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

Subtitle

14 "TO CREATE THE CRIME OF VIDEO VOYEURISM. "

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. (a) It is unlawful to use any camera, video tape photo-
20 optical, photo-electric, or any other image recording device for the purpose
21 of secretly observing, viewing, photographing, filming, or video taping a
22 person present in a residence, place of business, school, or other structure,
23 or any room or particular location within that structure, where that person is
24 in a private area out of public view, has a reasonable expectation of privacy,
25 and has not consented to the observation.

26 (b) The violation of this act is a Class D felony.

27 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any of the
28 following:

29 (1) Video recording or monitoring conducted pursuant to a court
30 order from a court of competent jurisdiction;

31 (2) Security monitoring operated by or at the direction of an
32 occupant of a residence;

33 (3) Security monitoring operated by or at the direction of the
34 owner or administrator of a place of business, school, or other structure;

35 (4) Security monitoring operated in motor vehicles used for
36 public transit;
