18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-906, concerning the duty of sex
21 offenders to register, is amended by adding an additional subsection to read
22 as follows:

23 (e)(1) An offender required to register pursuant to the provisions of
24 this subchapter shall not change his or her name unless the change is:

25 (A) Incident to a change in the marital status of the
26 offender; or

27 (B) Is necessary to effect the exercise of religion of the
28 offender.

29 (2) The change in the offender's name shall be reported to the
30 Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center within thirty (30) calendar
31 days after the official change in name.

32 (3) A violation of this subsection shall constitute a Class D
33 felony.
