22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-51-306(2), concerning overtaking a vehicle
25 on the left, is amended to read as follows:

26 (2) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is permitted, the
27 driver of an overtaken vehicle shall yield to the right in favor of the
28 overtaking vehicle ~~on audible signal~~ and shall not increase the speed of his
29 vehicle until completely passed by the overtaking vehicle.
