18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Katie's Law".
21

22 SECTION 2. When any sexual offense, as defined by Arkansas Code 5-14-
23 101 through 123, is committed against any person, who, at the time of the
24 sexual offense, was traveling within this state by private motor vehicle,
25 common carrier, watercraft, or other mode of transportation, and law
26 enforcement is unable to determine the county in which the sexual offense was
27 committed, the venue for prosecuting the person committing the sexual offense
28 may be in any county of this state from, through, or to which the victim
29 traveled.
