
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-406(c)(1), concerning special absentee
21 ballots, is amended to read as follows:

22 (c)(1) For the qualified electors in the categories named in
23 subsection (a) of this section who are ~~active duty military personnel~~
24 ~~stationed overseas~~ temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the
25 United States, the county board of election commissioners shall prepare a
26 special absentee ballot for each preferential primary and general election to
27 be sent to the voter in addition to the regular absentee ballot.

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-416(f)(1), concerning the counting of
30 absentee ballots, is amended to read as follows:

31 (f)(1) Absentee ballots marked as "special runoff ballots" received
32 from a qualified voter who meets one (1) of the categories in § 7-5-406(a)
33 and is temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the United
34 States shall be opened for general primary elections and general runoff
35 elections according to the procedures described in subsection (b) of this
