12 ADMINISTRATORS, AND EMPLOYEES; TO CLARIFY RECORD
13 RETENTION REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-24-102(8), concerning definitions for
27 ethical guidelines and prohibitions for educational administrators,
28 employees, and board members, is amended to read as follows:

29 (8) "Directly" or "directly interested" means receiving compensation
30 or other benefits personally or to ~~a business or other entity in which the~~
31 ~~individual has a financial interest or receives other benefits~~ an
32 individual's household from the person, business, or entity contracting with
33 the public educational entity;
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35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-24-105(d), concerning school boards, is
36 amended to read as follows:



1 (d) Records. The department and the public educational entity shall
2 maintain, under their respective record retention policies, a record and copy
3 of all documentation relating to transactions or contracts with board members
4 or members of their families.

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6 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-24-106(c)(6), concerning administrators,
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 (c)(6) The Department of Education and the public educational entity
9 shall maintain, under their respective record retention policies, a record
10 and copy of all documentation relating to an exemption from the provisions of
11 this chapter.

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13 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-24-107(c), concerning employees, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 (c) Documentation. The department and the public educational entity
16 shall maintain, under their respective record retention policies, a record
17 and copy of all documentation relating to transactions with employees.
