Subtitle of House Bill No. 2667

"TO PROVIDE FREE TUTORING TO TENTH AND ELEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS WHO
SCORE BELOW NINETEEN (19) ON THE AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2667.

Amend House Bill No. 2667 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 9, delete "FREE" and substitute "REMEDIAL"

AND

Page 1, delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:
"TO PROVIDE REMEDIAL TUTORING TO TENTH AND ELEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS WHO SCORE
BELOW NINETEEN (19) ON THE AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST."

AND

Page 1, line 25, delete "Free" and substitute "Remedial"

AND

Page 1, delete line 26 and substitute the following:
"(a) A school district shall provide remedial tutoring for a student
in grades"

AND

Page 1, delete line 30 and substitute the following:
"exam.
(b) The expenditure by a school district of its national school lunch
student funding under § 6-20-2305(b)(4) for the purposes of providing
remedial tutoring under this section shall be a permissible use of the
funding under § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(C)(i)."
