**Subtitle of House Bill No. 2287**

CONCERNING SEARCH WARRANTS FOR FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION; TO PROVIDE FOR  
MANDATORY MINIMUM SENTENCES; AND TO BE KNOWN AS "JENNY'S LAW".

**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2287**

Amend House Bill No. 2287 as originally introduced:

Page 1, lines 8 through 13, delete the title and substitute:

"AN ACT TO BE KNOWN AS "JENNY'S LAW"; TO PROVIDE FOR MANDATORY MINIMUM  
SENTENCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, lines 17 through 20, delete the subtitle and substitute:

"TO BE KNOWN AS "JENNY'S LAW"; AND TO PROVIDE FOR MANDATORY MINIMUM  
SENTENCES."

AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, is amended  
to create a new section to read as follows:

5-4-703. Mandatory minimum sentence for certain felonies.

In addition to any other authorized sentence, a person is subject to a  
mandatory minimum sentence of a term of imprisonment of five (5) years upon  
conviction for a felony offense if at the time of the commission of the  
felony offense the person:

(1) Has a prior felony conviction for a felony involving  
violence as defined in § 5-4-501(d);

(2) Is subject to an order of protection as provided under § 9-  
15-201 et seq.; and

(3) Is in the possession of a firearm."
