Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 81

Amend Senate Bill No. 81 as originally introduced:

Page 9, delete lines 9 through 12, and substitute the following:

~~"(a) A person arrested for violating § 5-65-103 shall be tried on those charges or plead to those charges, and no such charges shall be reduced~~
A person arrested for violating § 5-65-103 shall be tried on the charge of violating § 5-65-103 or plead to the charge of violating § 5-65-103, and the charge of violating § 5-65-103 shall not be reduced or dismissed."

AND

Page 11, line 14, delete "thirty (30) days" and substitute "five (5) business days"

AND

Page 15, line 25, delete "three (2)" and substitute "three (3)"

AND

Page 19, delete line 24, and substitute the following:

"found guilty of violating § 5-65-103 for a fourth or subsequent offense occurring within"

AND

Page 28, delete lines 13 through 16, and substitute the following:

~~"(e) The (d) A restricted driving permit issued under this section shall not be granted to any a person whose driving privilege was suspended or revoked for a second or subsequent offense of violating § 5-65-103, § 5-65-205, § 5-65-303, or § 5-65-310 a second or subsequent time within five (5) years of the first offense."~~

Page 34, delete lines 11 through 14 in their entirety.

AND

Page 47, line 4, delete "thirty (30) days" and substitute "five (5) business days"
