Subtitle of House Bill No. 1578

CONCERNING OFFENSES INVOLVING RIOTS, INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL OR FIRST RESPONDERS, DISORDERLY CONDUCT, AND OBSTRUCTING A HIGHWAY OR OTHER PUBLIC PASSAGE; AND ESTABLISHING CIVIL LIABILITY.

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1578

Amend House Bill No. 1578 as originally introduced:

Delete the title in its entirety and substitute the following:

"AN ACT CONCERNING OFFENSES INVOLVING INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL OR FIRST RESPONDERS; ESTABLISHING CIVIL LIABILITY UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"CONCERNING OFFENSES INVOLVING INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL OR FIRST RESPONDERS; AND ESTABLISHING CIVIL LIABILITY."

AND

Delete SECTIONS 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 in their entirety

AND

Page 5, delete line 36

AND

Page 6, delete lines 1 through 6, and substitute the following:

"responder; or
(2) A riot or the activity of a rioter under § 5-71-201 et seq.,
may bring a civil action against the rioter or a person or entity that
incites the riot."
