"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTION
COMMISSIONERS; TO AMEND HOW COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TAKE THE
OATH; TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING ELECTIONS; TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING
POLL WORKERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Page 5, line 27, delete "person receiving" and substitute "person required to receive"

Delete SECTION 11 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(a)(2), concerning service as an election official, deputy county clerk, or additional deputy, is amended to read as follows:

(2) A person shall not serve as an election official if:

(A) The person is:

(i) Married to or related within the second degree of consanguinity to a candidate running for office in the election;

(ii) The spouse of a member of a county board of election commissioners, except the spouse of a member of a county board of election commissioners may work as a poll worker if no objection is made to his or her service as a poll worker to the county board of election commissioners within ten (10) calendar days after posting the list of officials; or

(iii) A county party chair or his or her spouse, except the county party chair or his or her spouse may work as a poll worker if no objection is made to his or her service to the county board of election commissioners within ten (10) calendar days after posting the list of officials; and

(B) Another person makes an objection to his or her service to the county board of election commissioners within ten (10) calendar days after posting the list of officials."
