TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF A NOVICE TEACHER UNDER THE TEACHER EXCELLENCE AND SUPPORT SYSTEM.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1189

Amend House Bill 1189 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 9, and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO AMEND NOVICE TEACHER MENTORING REQUIREMENTS"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"AN ACT TO AMEND NOVICE TEACHER MENTORING REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE TEACHER EXCELLENCE AND SUPPORT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:
 "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2806(d), concerning the requirement
for novice teacher mentoring under the Teacher Excellence and Support System,
is amended to read as follows:

(d) The Teacher Excellence and Support System also shall include novice teacher mentoring for each novice teacher employed at the public school that:

 $$\frac{\mbox{(1)}(\mbox{(A)}}{\mbox{(A)}}$$ Provides training and support to novice teachers to increase teacher retention;

(2)(B) Establishes norms of professionalism; and

(3)(C) Leads to improved student achievement by increasing effective teacher performance.

(2) However, a novice teacher who has completed an educator preparation program, including a Division of Elementary and Secondary Education-approved year-long residency, is not required to participate in novice teacher mentoring under this subsection (d)."
