Subtitle of House Bill 1384

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION
RESIDENCY EXPANSION BOARD.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1384

Amend House Bill 1384 as originally introduced:

Add Senator J. Dismang

AND

Page 1, delete lines 10 and 11, and substitute the following:

"MEDICAL EDUCATION RESIDENCY EXPANSION BOARD; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE GRADUATE
MEDICAL EDUCATION RESIDENCY EXPANSION
BOARD; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Page 7, delete line 11, and substitute the following:

"resident is present in the program."

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the



General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a great need for medical professionals throughout the state to serve residents; that summer deadlines are quickly approaching for programs that train new medical professionals and funding needs to be distributed as soon as possible to prepare these programs to begin training in the fall; and that this act is immediately necessary because having trained medical professionals to fill worker shortages throughout the state is vital to ensuring the health and safety of Arkansans. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
