TO AMEND THE ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS SAFETY ACT TO INCREASE THE
CRIMINAL PENALTIES AND CLARIFY THE CIVIL PENALTIES.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1678

Amend House Bill 1678 as originally introduced:

Add Representatives Bentley, Breaux, A. Brown, M. Brown, C. Cooper, Crawford, McGrew, Pilkington, Rose, Rye, Torres, Underwood, Womack

AND

Add Senator J. Payton

AND

Page 2, line 17, delete "for injunctive relief"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 28 through 30, and substitute the following:

"(E) The Attorney General; or

(F) Any resident of this state that receives a shipment of
abortion-inducing drugs for illegal purposes.

(d) Damages shall not be awarded to a plaintiff if the pregnancy
resulted from the plaintiff's criminal conduct.

(e) A violation of this subchapter is a deceptive and unconscionable"

Page 2, line 34, delete "(e)" and substitute "(f)"

AND

Page 2, line 36, delete "~~(e)~~(f)" and substitute "~~(e)~~(g)"

AND

Page 3, line 4, delete "~~(d)~~(g)" and substitute "~~(d)~~(h)"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 7 through 10, and substitute the following:

"~~(e)~~(i) If judgment is rendered in favor of the defendant and the court finds that the plaintiff's suit was frivolous and brought in bad faith, the court shall also render judgment for a reasonable attorney's fee in favor of the defendant against the plaintiff."

Page 3, line 11, delete "~~(f)~~(h)" and substitute "~~(f)~~(j)"
