Subtitle of Senate Bill 103

TO CREATE THE PHARMACY NONDISCRIMINATION ACT; TO REQUIRE PHARMACY
BENEFITS MANAGERS TO ACCEPT ANY PHARMACY OR PHARMACIST WILLING TO
ACCEPT RELEVANT AND REASONABLE TERMS OF PARTICIPATION; AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 103

Amend Senate Bill 103 as originally introduced:

Add Senators Irvin, M. Johnson as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 5, delete lines 8 through 19, and substitute the following:

"(5) "Relevant and reasonable terms of participation" means
terms and conditions that:

(A) Are consistent with applicable state and federal law;

(B) Are consistent with industry standards; and

(C) Do not arbitrarily or discriminatorily exclude a
qualified pharmacy or pharmacist."
