TO AMEND THE UNIFORM ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE POLICY ACT; AND TO GRANT
PAID LEAVE TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES IN THE EVENT OF THE DEATH OF A PUBLIC
EMPLOYEE'S FAMILY MEMBER OR CHILD.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 241

Amend Senate Bill 241 as engrossed S3/17/25 (version: 3/17/25 02:19:49 PM):

Page 2, delete lines 15 through 26, and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) As used in this section, "immediate family member" means the father, mother, sister, brother, husband, wife, child, grandmother, grandfather, grandchild, in-laws, or any individual acting as parent or guardian of the employee.

(B) As used in subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section, "child" means:

- (i) A biological child;
- (ii) An unborn child;
- (iii) A stepchild;
- (iv) An adoptive child; or
- (v) A child in foster care who has been placed in the home of the employee."

AND

Page 4, delete lines 10 through 12, and substitute the following:

"(f)(1)(A) If the administrator of a catastrophic leave program elects to grant catastrophic leave to an employee under subsection (c)(1)(B) of this section, the employee shall be eligible for up to forty (40) hours of catastrophic leave with pay each calendar year for the death of an immediate



family member."
