Page 2, delete lines 23 through 36, and substitute the following:
"(c) The enhanced penalty under this section is as follows:
(1) If the person is convicted of a Class D felony or an
unclassified felony with a maximum authorized term of imprisonment that does
not exceed six (6) years, the enhanced penalty shall be an additional term of
years not to exceed four (4) years;
(2) If the person is convicted of a Class C felony, a Class B
felony, a Class A felony, or an unclassified felony with a maximum authorized
term of imprisonment that is greater than six (6) years, but does not exceed
thirty (30) years, the enhanced penalty shall be an additional term of years
not to exceed ten (10) years; and
(3) If the person is convicted of a Class Y felony or an
unclassified felony with a maximum authorized term of imprisonment that
exceeds thirty (30) years or that includes a life sentence, the enhanced
penalty shall be an additional term of years not to exceed twenty (20)
years."
