Bill: SB253

Bill Subtitle: TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF A MANUFACTURED HOME UNIT.

Basic Change:

SB253 amends the definition of a "manufactured home unit" by removing a structure constructed for use as an office or classroom.

Under current law, a "manufactured home unit" is defined as "a structure constructed for use as a dwelling, office, or classroom which is more than eight feet in width or sixty feet in length and is capable of being moved upon the highways when combined with a pulling vehicle." SB253 removes offices and classrooms from the definition so that a manufactured home unit is limited to a structure constructed for use as a dwelling.

This bill provides clarification of which structures are considered a manufactured or mobile home.
