Bill Subtitle: TO ALLOW DISCLOSURE TO A JUDGE OF INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER BY THE OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OR CRIME VICTIMS REPARATIONS BOARD.

Basic Change:

SB356 authorizes the Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Department of Finance and Administration (OCSE) and the Crime Victims Reparations Board to disclose certain information obtained from the Arkansas Crime Information Center (ACIC) to a court of law.

Under current law, ACIC makes criminal history records available to OCSE and the Crime Victims Reparations Board. The information may not be subsequently disclosed except upon court order, or for the purpose of performing the duties of OCSE or the Crime Victims Reparations Board. SB356 allows OCSE and the Crime Victims Reparations Board to disclose information obtained from ACIC to a district court judge, circuit court judge, Judge of the Court of Appeals, or Justice of the Supreme Court upon request.

Information received by OCSE or the Crime Victims Reparation Board from ACIC regarding affected individuals may be made available to trial and appellate court judges.
