Bill Subtitle: TO REPEAL THE LAW REQUIRING THE OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT TO SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

Basic Change:

SB380 repeals § 25-10-118, which requires the Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Department of Finance and Administration (OCSE) to file a report on a semi-annual basis with the Legislative Council that summarizes certain information concerning OCSE's collection and enforcement activities.

The report currently required by § 25-10-118 is not required by federal law. The information contained in the report can be provided by OCSE upon request. Section 25-10-118 has been recodified several times and the original statute from which this provision was derived can be dated back to 1947.
