**Bill Subtitle: TO REPEAL THE LAW REQUIRING THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

**Basic Change:**

SB389 repeals the requirement that the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) provide a biennial report to the Governor and the General Assembly regarding the administration and enforcement of alcoholic beverage laws. The report must include the amount of vinous, spirituous, or malt liquors manufactured in the state and the disposition thereof, the increase or decrease in their consumption over the preceding year, the amount of taxes and permit fees collected, and other related information.

The requirement for the report has existed since 1993. DFA would still be able to provide any information regarding the administration and enforcement of alcoholic beverage laws to the Governor or General Assembly upon request.
