24	(2)(A) An advanced practice registered nurse's prescriptive

26	expressly authorized by the collaborative practice agreement, also to those		
27	hydrocodone combination products reclassified from Schedule III to Schedule		
28	II as of October 6, 2014.		
29	(B) An advanced practice registered nurse's prescriptive		
30	authority also extends to drugs listed in Schedule II if:		
31	(i) The prescription is for an opioid and the		
32	prescription is only for a five-day period or less; or		
33	(ii)(a) The prescription is for a stimulant.		
34	(b) A prescription for a stimulant shall meet		
35	the following criteria:		
36	(1) The prescription was originally

2	(2) The physician has evaluated the	
3	patient within six (6) months before the advanced practice registered nurse	
4	issues a prescription; and	
5	(3) The prescription by the advanced

8	(B) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall adopt rules	
9	for safe and appropriate prescribing of stimulant medications listed in	
10	Schedule II.	
11	(3)(A) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall promptly adopt	
12	rules applicable to an advanced practice registered nurse that are consistent	
13	with the Arkansas State Medical Board's rules governing the prescription of	
14	dangerous drugs and controlled substances.	
15	(B) Before approval of the Arkansas State Board of	
16	Nursing's rules, the Arkansas State Medical Board shall review the proposed	
17	rules and verify that the proposed rules are consistent with the Arkansas	
18	State Medical Board's rules concerning the prescription of dangerous drugs	
19	and controlled substances.
