25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-5-501 is amended to read as follows:
28	6-5-501. Definitions.
29	As used in this subchapter:
30	(1) <u>"Revolutionary War" means the insurrection of the thirteen</u>
31	(13) original American colonies that led to the formation of the United
32	States of America and lasted from 1775-1783;
33	(2) "Civil War" means the 1861-1865 American Civil War;
34	(3) "Civil War-era weapon" means an instrument used in offensive
35	or defensive combat during the Civil War or a modern reproduction;
36	(4) "Civil War reenactor" means a member of an organized group

1	acting out historical events from the Civil War and carrying an actual weapon
2	from that era or a reproduction;
3	(5)(3) "French and Indian War" means the portion of the war
4	between France and Great Britain that took place in what is now the United
5	States of America from 1754-1763;
6	(4) "Mexican-American War" means the war between the United
7	States and Mexico from 1846-1848;
8	(5) "School official" means a public school district
9	superintendent or principal, a private school superintendent or principal, a
10	president, chancellor, or dean of a publicly supported institution of higher
11	education, or a president or dean of a private institution of higher
12	education; and
13	(6) "School property" means any building, bus, campus, ground,
14	recreational area, athletic field, or other area or structure owned or in the
15	charge of a public school district, a private school, a publicly supported
16	institution of higher education, or a private institution of higher
17	education .
18	(7) "War of 1812" means the conflict between the United States
19	and Great Britain from 1812-1815;
20	(8) "War reenactor" means a member of an organized group acting
21	out historical events from a war defined in this section and carrying an
22	actual weapon from that era or a reproduction of a weapon from that era; and
23	(9) "War-era weapon" means an instrument used in offensive or
24	defensive combat during a war defined in this section or a modern
25	reproduction of such an instrument.
26	
27	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-5-502 is amended to read as follows:
28	6-5-502. Weapons.
29	<u>(a)</u> A person in this state who is a Civil War <u>war</u> reenactor <u>as defined</u>
30	<u>in § 6-5-501</u> may carry a Civil War <u>war</u> -era weapon on school property for
31	educational purposes so long as a school official grants approval in advance
32	and, if the weapon is a firearm, the firearm is unloaded.
33	(b) Subsection (a) of this section applies to the following wars:
34	(1) The Revolutionary War;
35	(2) The Civil War;
36	(3) The French and Indian War;
