24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF	ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Title</u> .	
27	This act shall be known and may be cited as	s the "Babies at School Act".
28		
29	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. Legislative fir	ndings and intent.
30	(a) The General Assembly finds that:	
31	(1) A parent or guardian who is a school emplo	yee has a responsibility to both his or
32	her job and his or her family; and	
33	(2) The first six (6) months of a child's life poses heightened demands of a parent.	
34	(b) This act is intended to increase school employee retention by allowing schools to	
35	permit a parent or legal guardian who is a school employee to bring his or her infant to work.

2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1, is amended		
3	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
4	6-17-125. Infants at school — Definitions.		
5	(a) As used in this section:		
6	(1) "Infant" means a:		
7	(A) Biological child, adopted child, or stepchild under six (6) months of age		
8	of a school employee; or		
9	(B) Foster child under six (6) months of age who has been placed in the		
10	home of a school employee; and		
11	(2) "School" means:		
12	(A) A public school district;		
13	(B) An open-enrollment public charter school; or		
14	(C) A private school.		
15	(b) A school may allow a school employee to bring his or her infant to work during a school		
16	day.		
17	(c) A school that permits a school employee to bring his or her infant to work during a		
18	school day under this section may:		
19	(1) Establish a school policy that includes without limitation:		
20	(A) The identification of an appropriate work environment		
21	(B) The acceptable work performance standard of the school employee		
22	while his or her infant is at his or her workplace during a school day; and		
23	(C) Safety guidelines for an infant who is brought to the workplace during a		
24	school day under this section; and		
25	(2) Allow the school employee to bring his or her infant to work during a school day		
26	upon the return of the school employee to the school following maternity leave offered by the		
27	school or otherwise taken by the school employee, as applicable.		
28	(d) The provisions of this section do not prohibit a school from		
29	allowing a school employee to bring to the school employee's workplace during		
30	a school day his or her:		
31	(1) Biological child, adopted child, or stepchild who is six (6) months of age or older		
32	<u>or</u>		
33	(2) Foster child six (6) months of age or older who has been placed in the home of		
34	the school employee.
