

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2025-075

REQUESTING THAT THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND
GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS STUDY THE PROCEDURE FOR REMOVAL OR
DECERTIFICATION OF COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, each of the seventy-five (75) counties in the State of
Arkansas has a county board of election commissioners responsible for
conducting elections within the county; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Election Commissioners oversees the county
boards of election commissioners and may decertify an election official from
appointment as an election official; and

WHEREAS, it is important to ensure a fair, transparent, and uniform
removal or decertification procedure for all county election commissioners;
and

WHEREAS, an analysis of the removal or decertification procedure for
county election commissioners would be beneficial for future policymaking,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL
AFFAIRS OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs
study the procedure for removal or decertification of county election
commissioners implemented by the State Board of Election Commissioners.
