19	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING FILING FEES
20	OF A CANDIDATE SEEKING NOMINATION BY A
21	POLITICAL PARTY; AND TO ESTABLISH A
22	RANGE FOR POLITICAL PARTY FILING FEES.

24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25	
26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-7-301(a), concerning political party
27	filing fees for candidates seeking nomination by that party, is amended to
28	read as follows:
29	(a) A political party may impose a filing fee for candidates seeking
30	nomination by that party. The filing fee for county, municipal, and township
31	offices shall be fixed by the county committee, as authorized by the state
32	executive committee. For all other races, the filing fee shall be established
33	by the state executive committee. On or before noon of the last day of the
34	political party filing period, all candidates at primary elections of
35	political parties shall file an affidavit of eligibility and any pledge
36	required by such party and shall pay the party filing fees required by the

1 party, as follows:

2 (1)(A) Candidates for United States Senator, for United States 3 Representative, and for all state offices shall file the pledge and the 4 affidavit of eligibility and pay the party filing fees with the secretary of 5 the state committee of the political party or his or her designated agent. 6 (B) The filing fee set by the political party's state 7 executive committee shall be an amount no more than five percent (5%) of the 8 salary of the office for which the candidate is seeking nomination. 9 (C) The political party's state executive committee may 10 set the amount of the filing fee at zero (\$0.00); 11 (2)(A) Candidates for district offices, including, but not 12 limited to, the offices of State Representative and State Senator, shall file the pledge and affidavit of eligibility with the secretary of the state 13 14 committee of the political party or his or her designated agent and pay the 15 party filing fees with the secretary of the state committee of the political 16 party or his or her designated agent. 17 (B) The filing fee set by the political party's state 18 executive committee shall be an amount no more than three percent (3%) of the 19 salary of the office for which the candidate is seeking nomination. 20 (C) The political party's state executive committee may set the amount of the filing fee at zero (\$0.00); and 21 22 (3) All candidates for county, municipal, and township offices, 23 candidates for county committee member, and delegates to the county 24 convention shall file the pledge and the affidavit of eligibility and pay the 25 party filing fees with the secretary of the county committee of the political 26 party. 27 28 29 Referred by Senator B.
