3	REQUESTING THAT THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RESPECTFULLY URGE
4	PRESIDENT DONALD J. TRUMP TO IMPLEMENT TARGETED RELIEF FOR
5	ARKANSAS FARMERS IN 2025.
6	
7	WHEREAS, agriculture is the backbone of Arkansas's economy but also an
8	essential pillar of America's food security, and Arkansas producers are now
9	facing severe challenges that have resulted in rising rates of bankruptcies
10	and closures of farms across the entire state; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, these challenges that are resulting in farm bankruptcies and
13	closures include high interest rates, unpredictable weather, volatile
14	markets, and disruptions in global trade, which are occurring alongside
15	dramatic declines in commodity prices and record high input costs for seed,
16	fertilizer, fuel, and agricultural equipment; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, if producers are forced out of business, the consequences will
19	ripple far beyond the farm gate, impacting rural banks, equipment dealers,
20	and local communities across the entire State of Arkansas; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, President Donald J. Trump and congressional leaders in both
23	parties have made efforts in past years on behalf of Arkansas agricultural
24	producers and rural communities to secure emergency assistance and disaster
25	relief that have been instrumental in helping Arkansas farmers withstand
26	unprecedented challenges; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Arkansas agricultural producers and rural communities are in
29	need of strong leadership from President Donald J. Trump and from both
30	parties in Congress to take action now, as farmers must soon make planting
31	and financial decisions that will determine whether they continue their
32	agricultural operations and production at all, and without additional
33	support, many may not have these options,

5	States Congress to develop and implement a targeted relief package for
6	producers for the 2025 crop year.
