ANSWER AND MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

COMES NOW the Respondent, Arkansas Department of Transportation, by and through its Staff Attorneys, Iván Martínez and Cody Eenigenburg, and for its Answer and its Motion for Summary Judgment, states the following:

1. That the Respondent does not dispute liability.
2. That the Claimant filed the instant claim for damages against Respondent.
3. There is no genuine dispute as to any material fact, and the Respondent is entitled to judgment as a matter of law, pursuant to Ark. R. Civ. Proc. 56.
4. That the Claimant is covered by an automobile insurance policy and must exhaust all their remedies, including their own insurance, pursuant to A.C.A. §25-44-302.
5. That the Respondent has agreed to pay the Claimant's \$1,000.00 insurance deductible.
6. It is reasonable for the Respondent to pay the Claimant's insurance deductible to enable them to use their own insurance with no out-of-pocket expense.
7. This is the maximum amount allowable under Arkansas Statute.
8. The Arkansas State Claims Commission should enter judgment in the amount of \$1,000.00, which is the maximum amount allowed by A.C.A. §25-44-302.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays for Judgment in the amount of \$1,000.00, and for all other just and proper relief to which it may be entitled.

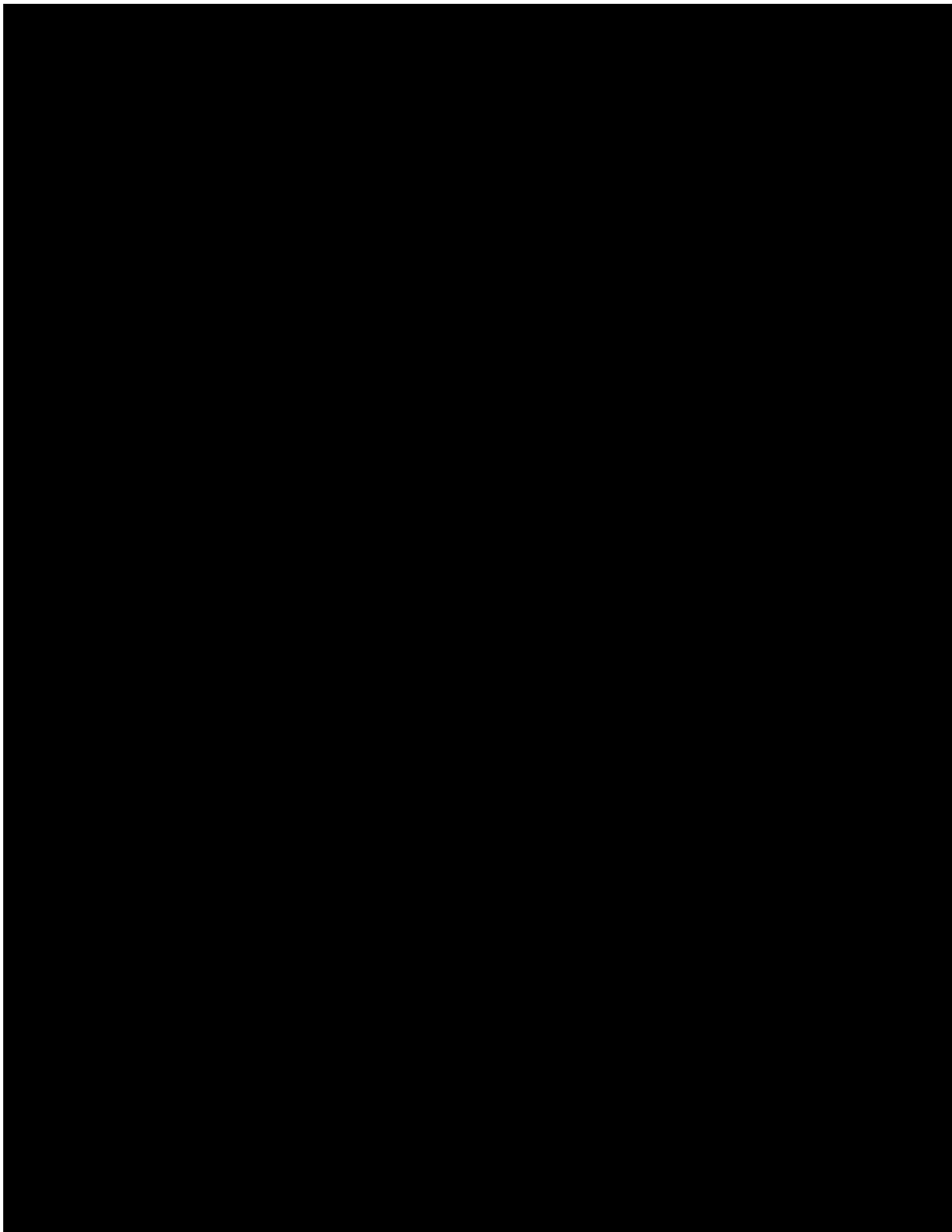

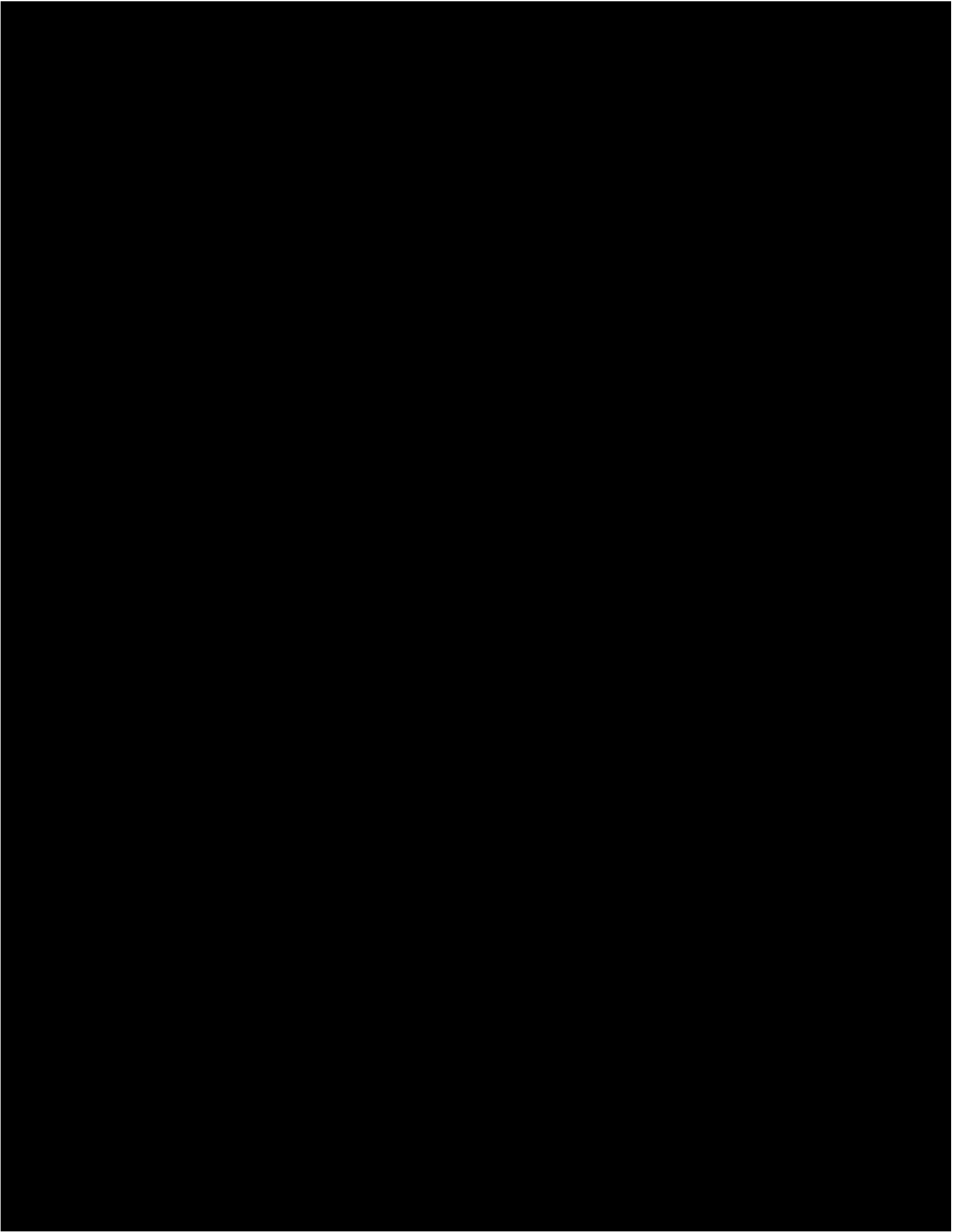

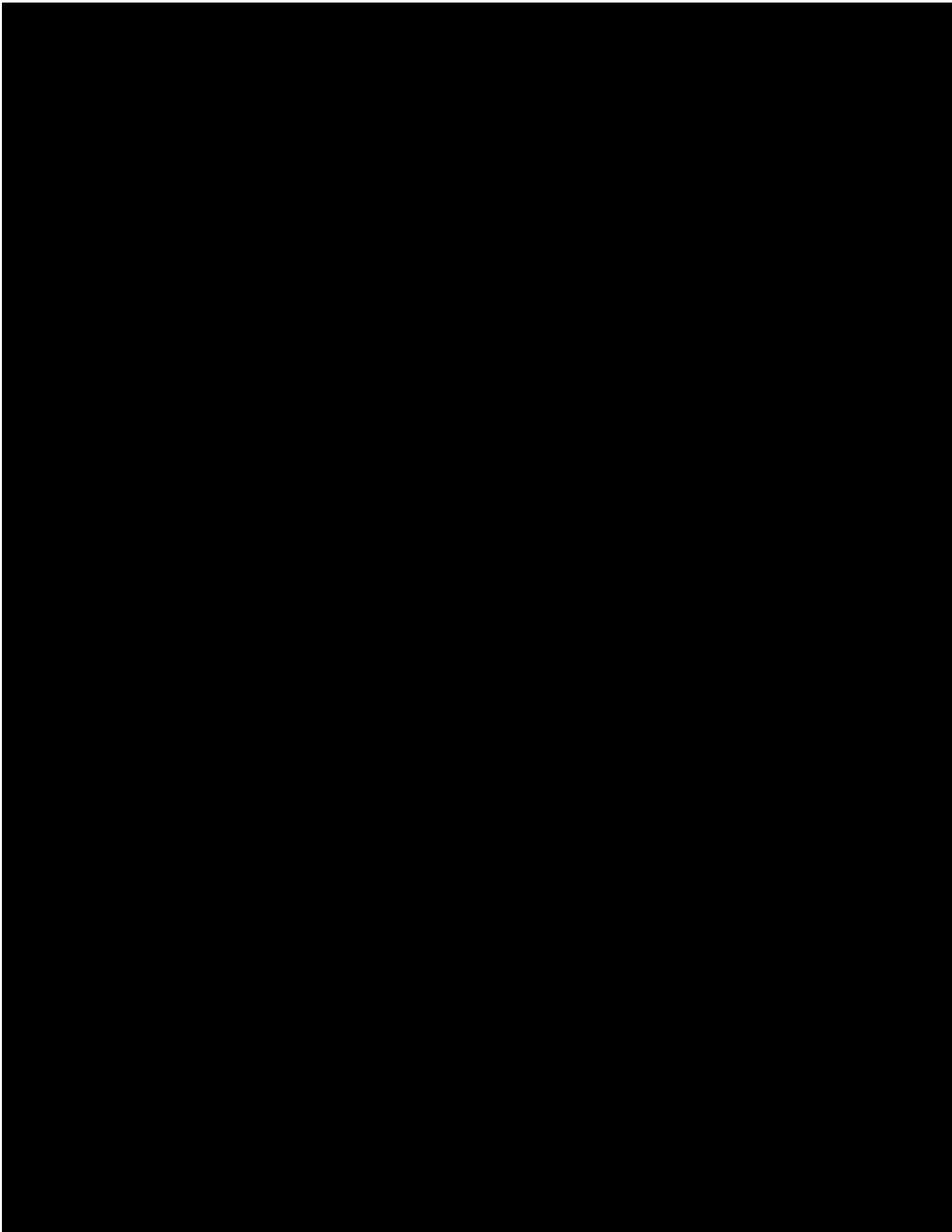

ORDER

Now before the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the “Commission”) is a motion filed by Arkansas Department of Transportation (the “Respondent”) for summary judgment as to the claim of David Williams (the “Claimant”). Claimant did not respond to the motion. Based upon a review of the motion, the arguments made therein, and the law of Arkansas, the Commission hereby finds as follows:

1. Claimant filed the instant claim on February 18, 2026, alleging that Claimant’s vehicle was damaged by wood thrown from Respondent’s bushhog machine.
2. Respondent filed a motion for summary judgment recommending payment in the amount of \$1,000.00, representing Claimant’s applicable insurance deductible.
3. Claimant did not respond or object.
4. Pursuant to Rule 56(c)(2), summary judgment is appropriate when there are no genuine issues as to any material fact, and the moving party is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. *See Hisaw v. State Farm Mut. Auto Ins. Co.*, 353 Ark. 668, 122 S.W.3d 1 (2003). Summary judgment motions are subject to a shifting burden, in that once the moving party has made a *prima facie* showing of entitlement to summary judgment, “the burden then shifts to the nonmoving party to show that material questions of fact remain.” *Flentje v. First Nat. Bank of Wynne*, 340 Ark. 563, 569, 11 S.W.3d 531, 536 (2000). Summary judgment is useful “when there is no real issue of fact

to be decided.” *Hughes W. World, Inc. v. Westmoore Mfg. Co.*, 269 Ark. 300, 301, 601 S.W.2d 826, 826 (1980).

5. The Commission finds that Respondent did make a *prima facie* showing in its motion that it was entitled to judgment as a matter of law as to the limited recovery available to Claimant under Ark. Code Ann. § 25-44-302.

6. By not responding, Claimant failed to demonstrate that there were any genuine issues of material fact precluding summary judgment.

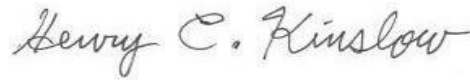
7. The Commission has reviewed the claim file and agrees with the parties that Respondent is entitled to judgment as a matter of law on Claimant’s recoverable damages.

8. As such, the Commission herein AWARDS Claimant \$1,000.00 as recommended by Respondent and orders the Respondent to pay claim out of current fiscal year revenue. Claimant’s claim for any other amount is hereby dismissed.
