Dear Senator Johnson and Representative Cavanaugh:

Under Arkansas Procurement Law, all non-exempt service contracts for must be presented for legislative review if they have an annual contract amount that equals or exceeds fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in any contract year or a total projected contract amount of three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) over the term of the contract. See Ark. Code Ann. § 19-61-116. With this letter, the Department of Shared Administrative Services, Office of State Procurement (OSP), is presenting for legislative review all such services contracts received this month.

In addition, the University of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR), Center for Integrative Nanotechnology Sciences (CINS), is requesting ratification of costs for purchases exceeding competitive bid thresholds totaling \$60,148.37. A contract between UALR/CINS and SigmaGraft, Inc., for semi-regular purchases of proprietary bone material to support medical research was procured using an outdated Sole Source approval. These purchases were required to maintain project continuity and any change regarding the vendor or product would have resulted in having to restart the FDA approval process and push development back several years.

None of the remaining contracts presented appear, on their face, to have been procured in violation of Arkansas Procurement Law. We request for their favorable review.

Additionally, as requested during the September 20, 2024, ALC meeting, I also note the date the original RFPs were issued, and the RFP method (MAP or Traditional) utilized for the procurement:

Re: Ratification Of SigmaGraft Inc., Good Purchase

In fiscal year 2026 Center for Integrative Nanotechnology Science engaged in purchases of proprietary bone material from SigmaGraft based on a sole source justification that was outdated.

The expenses in question are as follows:

RQ-0000643942 in the amount of \$10,015.98, pending approval

PO-1000697193 in the amount of \$10,015.98, dated 6/4/2026

PO-1000676446 in the amount of \$10,015.08, dated 4/27/2026

PO-1000666344 in the amount of \$10,015.08, dated 4/7/2026

PO-1000626026 in the amount of \$10,036.25, dated 1/13/2026

PO-1000584046 in the amount of \$10,050.00, dated 10/7/2025

These are semi-regular purchases supporting medical research with the potential for governmental adoption at the federal level. Purchase amounts through this vendor have exceeded competitive bid thresholds in fiscal year 2026. The PI's efforts having shifted into human clinical testing over this fiscal year necessitated escalation of production for the NuCress™ Bone Void Filler BVF using proprietary products only available through this supplier. These purchases were required to maintain project continuity, and, per the associated SSJ update, a change in vendor or product would necessitate restarting the FDA approval process, setting development back by several years.

Going forward, the department will ensure all necessary updates to any sole source justifications in the future when planning for purchases through this, or similar, suppliers as well as noting purchase thresholds with regards to the sole source.

Given the oversight was not malicious or intentional. And, considering no change in potential supplier's ability to meet the specifics of this need, it is in the best interest of Nanotechnology Science within their FDA approval(s) and therefore, should be paid.

Chief medical consultants are always monitoring production and quality of each of the agency's contract medical consultants. If a medical consultant is not performing at an acceptable level, this person can be counseled and/or trained on ways to improve their performance. Chief medical consultants also have the authority to move/remove work from contractors that are not achieving necessary efficiency or quality standards.

Finding qualified medical contractors can be difficult. For many years we have kept a standing ad on our website for doctors to contact us about work. Why is an RFQ the most suitable method of procurement?

The Department of Human Services (DHS) seeks approval to issue a multiple award Request for Qualifications (RFQ). The RFQ will identify qualified vendors interested in providing housing, educational support, employment readiness through vocational training, resume writing assistance, job search support, interview preparation, financial literacy, ongoing supervision from case workers when requested, and connecting youth with mental health services, healthcare, and insurance. The Supervised Independent Living (SIL) services will be provided to youth ages 18-21 who elect to participate in extended foster care. These youth may be the parent of one or more dependent children (maximum of two) who may be placed or reunited with the young adult in the Division of Children & Family Services (DCFS) approved SIL setting. The RFQ method is the most advantageous to the State of Arkansas because the qualifications of the vendors are the most important factors in the selection process due to the State's need to identify qualified vendors in each of the ten (10) DCFS service regions across the state. DHS wishes to create partnerships with all vendors who demonstrate the ability to implement the expectations of the program.

Why should cost not be considered in the procurement?

DCFS's ability to provide these services is contingent upon the availability and award of funding. As a result, DCFS will set a fixed rate for these services as they have for the past several years in order to be able to allocate the funding fairly across its service areas.

How will the cost of the contract be controlled?

DCFS has limited funding available to fund these services; therefore the cost of the contract will be controlled by

maintaining fixed rates and monitoring spending levels across all resultant contracts.
