The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) is formally requesting a transfer of cash appropriation in the amount of \$5,800,000 as authorized under Section 27 of Act 152 of 2024. This appropriation will be used to support the following UAMS programs:

- High Risk Pregnancy Program (HRPP, formerly ANGELS) – High-risk obstetrical telemedicine program serving rural hospitals, local health units, and rural provider offices to increase access to perinatal care services. Also provides 24/7 nurse facilitated toll-free call center that conducts high-risk OB patient referral scheduling, case management, and facilitates high-risk maternal transports across Arkansas.
- IDHI Stroke Program – Links rural emergency rooms to neurologists through live video 24 hours a day to ensure timely treatment of stroke patients.
- Newborn Screening – A statewide program to provide physician consultation, education, and secondary testing support for expanded newborn genetic testing.
- Following Baby Back Home – Ensures families with premature infants have access to social support, community services, and health developmental, and safety education.
- Sickie Cell – A 24/7 statewide system of support for patients with sickle cell disease and for the physicians who care for them.
