The Arkansas Division of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) Office of Early Childhood respectfully requests a transfer of \$200,000 in appropriation from Various Temporary Appropriation for State Agencies and Institutions pursuant to Section 32 of Act 1006 of 2025.

The Office of Early Childhood collects license fees annually from child care facilities (ACA 20-78-223). These funds are deposited into a special revenue fund to be used to provide grants to child care facilities for enhancement of the facility or for training of personnel in child care facilities and to meet the costs of conducting the statewide criminal records checks (ACA 19-6-465).

The transfer request will help provide appropriation to spend these special revenues as required by state law.
