2. Department of Commerce- The Arkansas Division of Workforce Services - Office of Skills Development will be the lead agency to establish the American Manufacturing Apprenticeship Incentive Fund to support the expansion of manufacturing registered apprenticeship nationwide. The Office of Skills Development will implement this project through a cooperative agreement with the Department of Labor. This agreement will achieve two administration priorities, support the resurgence of American manufacturing and expand Registered Apprenticeships to reach 1 million active apprentices. This incentive funding model will incentivize employers on a national scale to develop, expand, and/or join existing advanced manufacturing RA programs and hire apprentices. The incentive fund aims to stimulate innovation and reduce barriers that prevent employers from committing to registered apprenticeships, thus promoting program scale and sustainability.
