The Department of Transformation and Shared Services, Geographic Information Systems Office, respectfully requests \$1,200,000 from the Restricted Reserve Fund to support the procurement of updated statewide aerial imagery. This aerial imagery is corrected for terrain distortion and encoded with the latitude and longitude coordinates. Because a picture is worth a thousand words, this data is one of the most popular GIS data products published by the Office. It is widely used for economic development purposes at state and local levels. It is used by County Assessors to locate and discover real estate improvements, by County E911 to map roads, by numerous state agencies for a variety of purposes and by the private sectors including real estate, land surveying, engineering, utilities, agriculture, and forestry. GIS last procured this statewide image database in 2017 with one-time funding and it has become outdated.

The requested funds would support a statewide update of this important resource that will be used by state and local government, as well as the private sector and academia. If you have questions or need additional information, please contact me.
