The Arkansas Waterways Association has been granted \$40,000.00 from the Arkansas Economic Development Commission to have an economic impact study conducted on the White River Navigation System. The study will be conducted by the University of Arkansas, Maritime Transportation Research Education Center (MARTrec) with Dr. Heather Nachtmann, Ph.D. overseeing the project. The scope of the project will be to ascertain whether the lack of maintenance dredging by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the past nine (9) years and the non-existence of a commercial interest in the past four (4) years has caused the decline in the economy for the towns and cities along the White River.

Dear Mr. Baird:

We respectfully request \$1,035,000 and \$407,000 for the Arkansas State Veterans Homes in North Little Rock and Fayetteville respectively in FY19 cash appropriation. These appropriations are to pay for the anticipated overtime, operating and professional service requirements for through 30 June 2019.

Overtime Expenses at both facilities are a result of lack of planning in the previous budget cycle and increased staffing requirements driven by resident care.

Increased Operating Expenses at North Little Rock Veterans Home is due to extensive use of temporary service personnel in lieu of internal staff. In addition, there have been a few projects to correct original design oversights were required in the first few months of FY19 to bring the facility in line with requirements of the Center of Medicaid and Medicare Services and the Department of Veteran Affairs standards. These projects used some of the appropriations that would have been used for other operating expenses.

The increase in Professional Fees and Services is to more correctly allocate expenses in accordance with the cost categories. In the past, professional services were being incorrectly expensed as operating costs. This incorrect practice was corrected starting in FY19 and this additional appropriation will allow for proper expensing of costs.

All of these appropriations are consistent with expected operations and critical to the care delivery at both facilities.


Certification of income to match the above requested appropriation will be made available through a transfer of Rain Day Funds on an as required basis.
