25	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - GRANTS AND AID TO LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND				
26	SPECIAL PROGRAMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of				
27	Education, to be payable from the Division of Elementary and Secondary				
28	Education Public School Fund Account, for grants and aid to local school				
29	districts and special programs of the Department of Education - Division of				
30	Elementary and Secondary Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022,

- l be used solely for the implementation of the Educator Compensation Reform
- 2 Program. Funds shall be kept separate from all other monies in the Public
- 3 School Fund and are to be utilized over a four-year period, beginning July 1,
- 4 2019, to assist school districts in ensuring that all educators in Arkansas
- 5 public school districts receive a minimum annual salary of \$36,000 by July 1,
- 6 2023. The Educator Compensation Reform Fund shall not be considered part of

- 18 2019 may also be known as "NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH" funding or abbreviated as

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY EDUCATION CENTER FUNDING. Funds allocated by Henderson State University for the Community Education Center will be used exclusively for the operation and maintenance of the facility and to teach technical and industrial subjects for citizens and employers.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 24 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LOAN.
Notwithstanding the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated § 19-5-501,
immediately upon the effective date of this section, the President of
Henderson State University is authorized to request the Chief Fiscal Officer

of the State to make a loan on his or her books in the amount not to exceed six million dollars (\$6,000,000) from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to

33 the Henderson State University Fund. Loan repayments for the outstanding loan

34 <u>from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund shall be made from time to time from</u>

35 any legal fund of Henderson State University and the entire amount of the

36 loan shall be repaid to the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund no later than

1 June 30, 2028 or as recommended by the General Assembly upon review of the 2 loan status, which shall be presented to the Arkansas Legislative Council or 3 the Joint Budget Committee no later than June 30 each year. 4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2021 5 through June 30, 2022. 6 7 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 14 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 16 with in disbursement of said funds. 17 18 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26 27 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm

being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
