20-76-216. Restrictions on use of financial assistance.

(a) Financial assistance granted to a recipient of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program shall be used only to purchase goods and services that are considered essential and necessary for the welfare of the family, including without limitation:

(1) Food;

(2) Clothing;

(3) Housing;

(4) Utilities;

(5) Child care; and

(6) Incidentals, including without limitation transportation and medicine or medical supplies or equipment not covered by either the Arkansas Medicaid Program or the health benefit plan of the individual.

(b) A recipient of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program shall not make a cash withdrawal from an electronic benefit transfer card account that receives financial assistance under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program by electronic benefit transfer system.

(c) The Department of Workforce Services shall adopt and promulgate rules necessary to implement this section, including without limitation rules defining what goods and services constitute "essential and necessary" to implement subsection (a) of this section.

(d)(1) On or before October 1, 2016, the department shall request a waiver from the federal government to the extent necessary to implement this section.

(3) Be designed to effectuate a transfer no later than July 1, 2017; and

(4) Include any other information which the Capitol Zoning District Commission deems relevant."
