Dear Co-Chairs:

I respectfully request the following amendments to HB1284, the Medicaid Expansion Program Appropriation Bill for the Arkansas Department of Human Services for fiscal year 2017-2018:

Please amend SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - MEDICAL SERVICES - MEDICAID EXPANSION PROGRAM GRANTS as follows:

Please amend SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. MEDICAID EXPANSION PROGRAM – PAYING ACCOUNTS as follows:

MEDICAID EXPANSION PROGRAM – PAYING ACCOUNTS. The Medicaid Expansion Program as established by Initiated Act 1 of 2000 and enacted in the Tobacco Settlement Proceeds Act shall be a separate and distinct component embracing (1) expanded Medicaid coverage and benefits to pregnant women; (2) expanded inpatient and outpatient hospital reimbursements and benefits to adults aged nineteen (19) to sixty four (64); (3) expanded non-institutional coverage and benefits to adults aged 65 and over; and (4) creation and provision of a limited benefit package to adults aged nineteen (19) to sixty four (64), to be of the Arkansas Medicaid Program, administered by the Department of Human Services and established as set out in § 19-12-116(b)(1). Separate Paying Accounts shall be established for the Medicaid Expansion Program as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to be used exclusively for the purpose of drawing down federal funds associated with the federal share of expenditures and for the state

share of expenditures transferred from the Medicaid Expansion Program Account or for any other appropriate state match funds.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

This request allows for the agency to use Tobacco Settlement funds to provide services for those currently waiting for waiver services on the Developmental Disabilities Waiting List. This request is needed due to passage of Act 50 of 2017 for the funds to be used for any program established in Tobacco Settlement code.

21	Disabilities Waiver", does not have the capacity to provide assistance to
22	these individuals; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure the
23	health and safety of the individuals with intellectual and developmental
24	disabilities in the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
25	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
26	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
27	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
28	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
29	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
30	bill; or
31	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
32	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
