Scope of Practice: Boiler repair licenses are issued to individuals who hold state or national certifications to perform the

work. Boiler repair must only be performed by qualified state and nationally certified individuals who

hold credentials for both the type of unit and the specific repair.

Statutory Requirement(s): This is state required and used to insure only those recognized as an expert in the field of Boiler repair

are performing work on pressure vessels. The Section verifies both credentials and qualifications to

insure that repairs are performed in accordance with all national codes and standards.

ALC – Occupational Licensing Review Subcommittee Occupational Entity Questionnaire

Responses to the following questions are due via email to Subcommittee staff no later than the 15th of the month immediately preceding the month the occupational authorization is scheduled for review by the Subcommittee.

- 1. Would consumers be at risk of substantial harm if Arkansas did not have this occupational authorization? YES. The agency investigates all complaints and accidents and takes formal enforcement action on any non-certified repair company operating or any operator of a boiler in a hazardous situation. What instances of specific and substantial harm have been documented in the past year? The Boiler Safety licensing requirements are built upon a proactive inspection service using both State and National Insurance inspectors to prevent accidents or explosions as a result of pressure and steam vessels. During the reporting period 150 vessels were placed out of service due to failure to meet minimum safety standards.
- 2. How many complaints were made to the occupational entity by consumers being harmed by unauthorized practitioners? The agency received 72 complaints regarding expiration of operating certificates and 5 complaints of a boiler operating in an unsafe or hazardous manner. Inspections were performed on these vessels. Any violations were required to be corrected. The five complaints regarding an unsafe operating condition resulted in 3 vessels being removed from service and 2 were not valid. The Boiler and its pressure are highly regulated by the insurance industry and state and national guidelines. The agency is required to maintain "Cradle to Grave" records and tracking for all boiler vessels in Arkansas to ensure that decommissioned vessels are prevented from being operated and to prevent noncertified repairs from being conducted. This is also reported to the National jurisdiction online reporting system and included in all inspection reports. What specific action was taken by the occupational entity?
- 3. How many complaints were made to the occupational entity by consumers being harmed by <u>authorized</u> practitioners? What specific action was taken by the occupational entity?

 The Boiler program removed 20 vessels from service based on failed inspections through a red tag program. When a red tag is issued the fuel source is removed

from the vessel and the vessel must be replaced or repaired to meet or exceed the ASME standards.

- 4. Were any applicants who otherwise met authorization requirements denied an authorization in the past year? **NO** If so, why?
- 5. How much does the occupational entity collect annually in fees, and what are annual expenses? \$786,2250.00 with an expenditure of \$717,388.00 for FY23 How much money does the occupational entity have in reserves? \$1,097,250.03
- 6. If the occupational entity has a positive amount in reserves, when was the last time reserve funds were used? Program reserves average is one-year operating expense. For what purpose? Reserves are used for operating expenses. 2023 reserve funds were used to buy new vehicles, and online meeting communications upgrades.
- 7. Does the occupational entity have any other sources of revenue? The **Boiler Section has** a certificate of operation program for all regulated vessels in Arkansas. Could occupational authorization fees be reduced without causing the occupational entity to be underfunded? **NO**
- 8. How many applicants for the occupational authorization fail each year? The Boiler Section averages a 30% failure rate of passage of the test for licensure. Of the 30% failure rate 50% pass on their second attempt. National certification of Boiler and pressure vessel inspectors are tested by the National Boiler Board. Does the occupational entity track how many applicants that do not progress are veterans, women, or minorities? No, but the Boiler Section expedites licensing for veteran/spouse applicants.
- 9. Can applicants complete the training requirements for this occupational authorization with vocational or non-traditional education (e.g., apprenticeships)? What percentage of applicants complete apprenticeships? **Yes- No known apprenticeships for boiler operators in Arkansas.**
- 10. In what ways would removal of the occupational authorization or reduction of occupational authorization requirements be harmful to current authorization holders? An untrained, non-regulated boiler operator workforce could lead to boilers being operated outside of safe operating parameters that can cause an unstable condition

that leads to an explosion that can result in death, injuries, and major property damage.
