 - A. The competitors would not fight in Arkansas if there is no sanctioning body to document the WIN or LOSS records.
 - B. There would be safety concerns related to unregulated events "fight club" type events due to the potential for blood-borne pathogen transmission and medical concerns related to undocumented concussions.
