JUSTIFICATION

DOM needs two positions to assist with its strategic goal of enhancing digital infrastructure and enabling advanced, data driven decision making.

The responsibilities of the Data Scientist position include developing predictive models and machine learning algorithms to analyze large and complex datasets, collecting data from assorted sources, cleaning and preprocessing this data to ensure consistency and usability for modeling and analysis, using advanced analytics to provide data driven insights leading to recommendations that inform executive decision making and improve public services outcomes, creating a variety of visualizations tailored for non-technical stakeholders, introducing new techniques to enhance analytic capabilities while aligning with pre-determined federal and state data management directives, as well as ensuring compliance with cybersecurity and data protection standards.

The responsibilities of the Data Analyst position include facilitating the integration of data from disparate sources using extract, transform, and load methodologies to create unified datasets for analysis. This involves collecting, cleaning, and organizing data from multiple sources and performing data validation and quality checks to ensure accuracy and consistency. During evaluation, this position conducts statistical analysis and then generates reports to support readiness, manpower, budget, and mission planning. This position is additionally responsible for creating dashboards and other visualizations tailored for both leadership and non-technical personnel, developing monitoring protocols to audit data quality and identify anomalies, recommending improvements to data processes to ensure compliance with security standards, as well as collaborating with a variety of internal personnel to ensure data requirements are met and reporting is accurate.

RECOMMENDATION

OPM has reviewed this request from DOM and recommends the establishment of two (2) surrender pool positions authorized as IDN03P, Data Scientist and IDN01P, Data Analyst. The cost for these two (2) surrender pool positions is approximately \$95,373.62. The funding source for this projected cost is general revenue, and DOM will seek federal funding for use of these positions. DOM guarantees our office that it possesses sufficient funding to support this surrender pool position request.

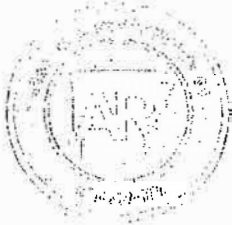

The Arkansas Department of the Military respectfully requests two (2) Growth Pool positions from the Office of Personnel Management to establish a Data Scientist and Data Analyst position. In exchange, the Agency has identified two (2) positions to surrender that will be vacant and are authorized within the Department. The agency will fund the difference in the salary of the Data Scientist and Data Analyst positions and the surrendered positions within the current budget and with future vacancies.

The Data Scientist and Data Analyst positions are critical to the Department's strategic goal of enhancing digital infrastructure and enabling data-driven decision-making. The individual selected for the Data Scientist role will apply advanced statistical analysis, machine learning, and predictive modeling to support policy development, operational readiness, and resource optimization across the agency. The individual selected for the Data Analyst role will support the collection, validation, and analysis of data from multiple state and federal sources to ensure accuracy, consistency, and usability.

These positions will directly enable the Agency to leverage big data, improve forecasting, and provide actionable insights that strengthen both state and federal mission success.
