Restricted Reserve Fund Transfer Request

Secretary Walther,

The Arkansas Department of Education Division of Elementary and Secondary Education requests a Fiscal Year 2022 transfer of \$35,000,000 from the Restricted Reserve Fund for the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education Public School Fund. This request, which was recommended by the Board of Finance in a meeting on June 8, would provide additional support to the Employee Benefits Division for health insurance contributions for the public school employees' health insurance program. This funding would be transferred to a sub-fund of the DESE Public School Fund to be used solely to provide additional support for the public school employees' health insurance program.
